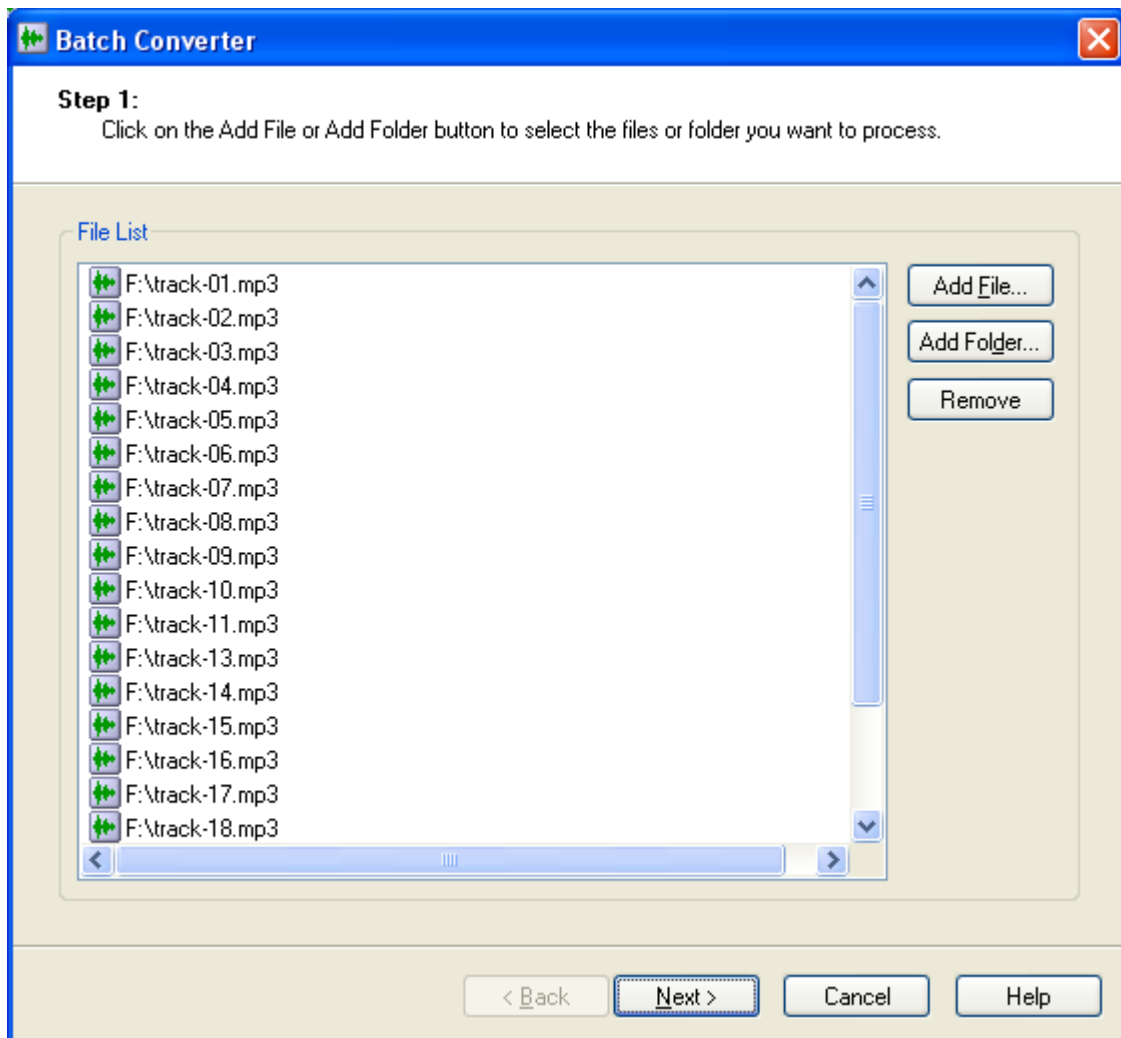
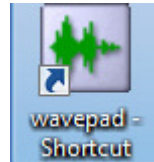


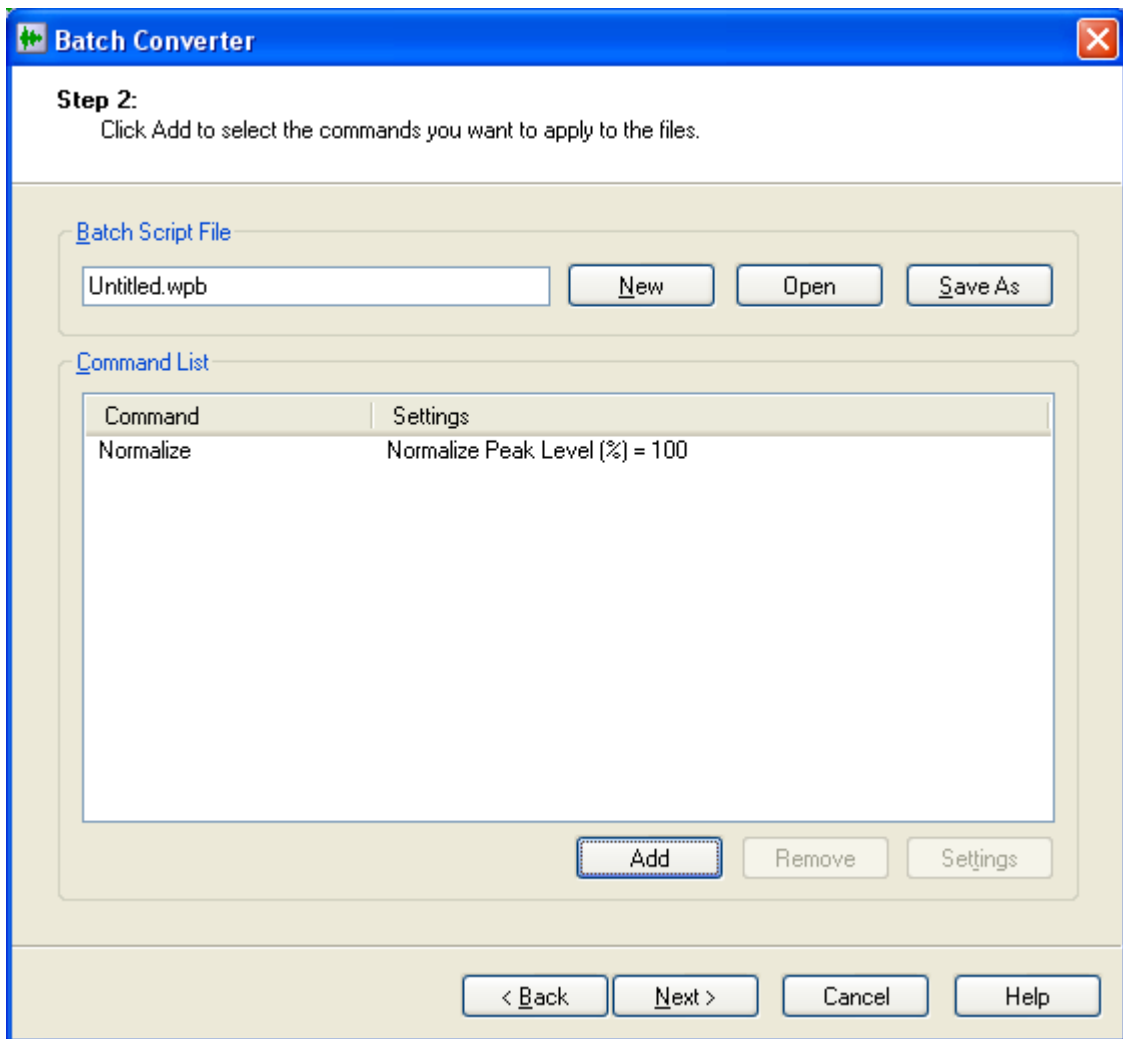
Normalisation for Memory Stick & CD

On those odd occasions when we don't manage to record all the tracks at the same level, we have in the past used Nero's normalisation mechanism. With the need to deliver the product on memory sticks the Nero method is not enough since it only produces normalised CDs - the memory stick versions we make will still have the original level variations. Happily there is a solution because WavePad has a "batch" mode which allows us to specify that all the files in a particular folder should be normalised. Here is how it works.

First start WavePad by clicking on its icon on the desktop. When WavePad opens up, click on the button in the "Tools" menu labelled "Batch Processor". This will bring up a window asking for individual files or folders of files, which we want to normalise.



Click on the button "Add Folder" to find the window above, showing the files to be normalised and then, if the file list is correct, click on "Next" to find this window -



Here, we can ignore the address of the “Batch Script” file and get a list of available commands by clicking on the “Add” button. Choose “Normalise” and then “Next”. On the following window just accept the defaults by clicking on “Finish” - the Normalisation will then begin and will take about 3 mins.
